## **CCNA THRESHOLDS HAVE INCREASED**


## WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Beginning July 1, 2020, thresholds for continuing services contracts under the Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) increased.

HB 0441 increased the maximum limit for continuing contracts covered by the CCNA to an estimated per-project construction cost of \$4 million and increased the maximum limit for procuring studies to \$500,000.

This includes study fees and construction costs for:

- Engineering
- Landscape Architecture
- Surveying
- Architecture
